We only survive if people come to visit our store. With that said, Salted Desert will be instituting the following precautions effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020.

WE WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTING BY-APPOINTMENT-ONLY HALOTHERAPY SESSIONS. AT THIS TIME, WE WILL NOT ACCEPT WALK-IN VISITS. THIS IS DONE TO ENSURE EXTRA DOWNTIME FOR SANITATION AND CLEANING OF BOOTHS AND COMMON AREAS BETWEEN CLIENT SESSIONS.

PLEASE MAKE APPOINTMENTS PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL, EITHER ONLINE OR BY PHONE.

PRE-SCREENING:

All first-time clients MUST CALL and speak to a Salted Desert representative prior to arrival for your session. You will be asked several basic questions about your reason for seeking halotherapy and your current health status, including: any recent history of fever, respiratory infection, and recent exposure to anyone with an active contagious disease.

If there is any likelihood that you have active symptoms of the FLU or CORONAVIRUS you will NOT BE PERMITTED to attend your session.

ALL CLIENTS upon arrival to Salted Desert can be asked some of the health questions mentioned above. If you feel like you may have a fever (chills, headache) we ask that you not come in for your halotherapy session. Fever is one of the hallmark signs of a viral infection. We do not want to take any chance of infecting other, healthy individuals.

HALOTHERAPY SESSIONS WILL BE SCHEDULED WITH A MINIMUM OF 30 MINUTES BETWEEN THE TIME THE LAST CLIENT USE AND THE NEXT. THIS WILL ALLOW EXTRA TIME FOR THE SALT BOOTHS TO BE PROPERLY VENTILATED AND WIPED DOWN WITH APPROPRIATE CLEANERS. WE WILL BE CLEANING ALL COMMON AREAS WITH INCREASED FREQUENCY.
